

Required Information For Electronic Filing

Per IRS publications 1345 and 1346

Form **W-2 If you received a W-2, this is required** - Complete Form W-2 for each Form W-2 you received for wages

Note If you have more than one W-2, click **Add** to enter information for each W-2 separately. If you don't have a W-2, you don't need to click **Add**.

Form **1099-R If you received a 1099-R, this is required** - complete form 1099-R if you received distributions from pensions, annuities, retirement or profit-sharing plans, IRAs, Insurance contracts, etc. and received a form 1099R.

Federal income tax withholding from other 1099s (such as 1099-G):

Form **W-2G If you received a W-2G, this is required** - complete Form W2-G for each form W-2G you received for gambling winnings

IMPORTANT: Identifying Information From Last Year (2009 taxes)

The IRS uses this information to verify your identity. They will attempt to match this information with their records so don't guess. If the information does not match, your return will be rejected. If you don't have a prior year Adjusted Gross Income or prior year PIN, you can obtain an Electronic Filing PIN from the IRS web site.

Enter the Electronic Filing PIN in the space indicated "Prior Year PIN/Electronic Filing PIN".

Note: If you are married filing joint, and you filed together in 2009, enter the same amount in the taxpayer and spouse columns for adjusted gross income.
